The classes are on a donation basis. There will be an opportunity to give each week. Proceeds will go to the teachers for their time and travel costs.

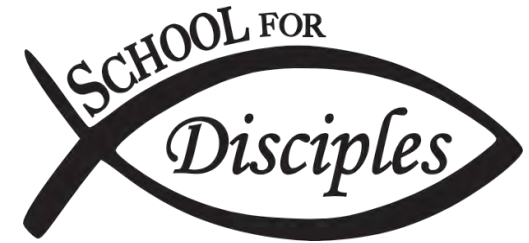
